I. Biographical Note:

Portable Channel was a non-profit community video center that existed in Rochester, N.Y from 1970-1987. Founded by Bonnie Sherr Klein, Portable Channel supported community access to video equipment, provided training, and produced programs with an emphasis on community activism and documentary work. Portable Channel's mission was to expand television into a medium for social dialog and artistic expression by encouraging community involvement in TV production. Portable Channel was one of the first community video centers to have regularly scheduled programming on broadcast television (Homemade TV 1972-1975).

II. Scope and Content:

The collection consists of photographic materials, meeting minutes, correspondence, posters, newspaper clippings, financial information and other materials related to Portable Channel.
